The Senior Data Analyst provides timely and accurate financial and credit reporting for the Association, analyzes and prepares reports to streamline processes, and provides subject matter expertise on projects. The Senior Data Analyst reports to the Managing Director, Business Information.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Administer the Association's BI Governance Function, including;
 - a. Tracking and monitoring of report repository and index.
 - b. Tracking and prioritizing new report requests, including approval, validation, and user acceptance testing (UAT).
 - c. Tracking and formalizing report modifications and terminations.
 - d. Monitors and recommends changes in Scope to the BI Governance policy and procedures.
- 2. Responsible for leading data validation efforts, including:
 - a. Performing regular audits to evaluate the quality and integrity of the data across all reporting lines.
 - b. Reporting results to Chief Risk Officer, Managing Director of Business Intelligence, and the Information Technology Group (ITG), as required.
- 3. Responsible for the preparation and validation of key Association reports, including:
 - a. Maintaining expert knowledge of all main data sources, leading change management across functional units and external partners to ensure quality and completeness of BI at enterprise level.
 - b. Leading the design and execution of dashboards, reports and scorecards that deliver and process critical data to support Association objectives.
 - c. Preparing various financial information and analysis using in-house business intelligence tools.
 - d. Analyzing the data to verify accuracy and identify trends.
 - e. Working across functional areas to understand and identify reporting objectives to develop relevant reporting.
 - f. Building reports using combination of SAP Business Objects, SQL language and Access Database.





- 4. Participating in special projects by providing subject matter expertise, preparing documents, analyzing processes and recommending improvements, and documenting new procedures.
- 5. Serving as backup to Chief Risk Officer and/or Manager Director, Business Information on assignments, special projects process improvements and reporting.
