Fresno Madera Farm Credit to Distribute \$10.4 Million To Members

Fresno, CA – April 1, 2019 – Fresno Madera Farm Credit, ACA, located in California's Central Valley announced today that it will return \$10.4 million to their members in the form of a cash patronage distribution based on 2018 earnings; a slight increase from last year.

Overall, Fresno Madera Farm Credit earned \$20.0 million in net income for 2018, so this patronage distribution represents more than 50% of 2018 total earnings. "Our board fully understand the value created by our patronage program; we're very pleased about our financial results, and the amount of our earnings we're able to return to the members, while keeping the Company well-positioned for the future" stated Jeff Jue, Chairman of the Board.

In addition, our cooperative structure enables us to return a portion of our earnings back to the membership in the form of a 100% cash distribution.
